Session 1: Assessing the Impact of Intervention - The Future Cancer Burden of Construction Workers

Paul Demers is the Director of the Occupational Cancer Research Centre, based at Ontario Health and a Professor with the University of Toronto's Dalla Lana School of Public Health. He has a PhD in epidemiology and Master's degree in occupational hygiene and his research has focused primarily on occupational cancer, lung disease, and heart disease.

He has been a member of many national and international expert panels and Committees dealing with occupational cancer for organizations such as the International Agency for Research on Cancer, the UN Environment Program, the US National Toxicology Program, the US Institute of Medicine, and the American Conference of Governmental Industrial Hygienists.

Marc began his career at INCO Ltd in Sudbury at the Iron Ore Recovery Plant in Environmental Control conducting stack sampling and establishing an industrial hygiene program. He assisted in the commissioning and operation of INCO's powder metallurgy rolling mill that produced alloys for coinage. During these years, he had positions in operations and health and safety management.

Marc then joined the Industrial Accident Prevention Association conducting audits of safety programs, investigating industrial hygiene issues and delivering seminars on health and safety elements. He was promoted to Area Supervisor and then assumed Regional Manager responsibilities.

In 2000, Marc joined the Ontario Ministry of Labour as part of the Occupational Exposure Limits Initiative and worked in Northern, Eastern and Central Regions as an Industrial Hygienist covering all sectors.

In January 2013, he was promoted to the position of Provincial Hygienist. As the provincial hygiene program lead of the Ministry of Labour, Marc provides leadership in strategic planning and delivery of occupational hygiene services. His portfolio includes industrial hygiene aspects of the sector regulations, occupational exposure limits, designated substances, GHS/WHMIS, industry-wide air quality surveys and developing occupational hygiene work plans consistent with the Ministry Safe at Work Ontario's objectives.

Marc is a Certified Industrial Hygienist and a Registered Occupational Hygienist.
